COUNCIL CORNER FOR DECEMBER 2022

Apostle: There is one more set of Altar Paraments left to have cleaned plus the two flags. This should be completed by the end of the year. Counsel agreed that the dry cleaners being used is doing a great job at a reasonable price.

Poinsettia sales are good this year with around 22 being ordered.

Turkey donations for the community Thanksgiving dinners were good this year. We sent a total of 14 turkeys to two different churches in the Alliance area.

We are still looking for someone to step up and take charge of the Apostle duties.

<u>Deacon:</u> The November financial report was presented to the council and approved by unanimous vote.

Hunter bank has already started sending the extra \$7000 per month to help with the bills. Hopefully the money will not be needed until the new year.

Brian McKarns was able to report that at the time the funds will be expended for this project are in the area of \$20,150 plus the new pulpit at approximately \$2200. Funds allotted for the project were \$25,000.

Elder: For the month of November the Food Pantry served 62 families for a total of 129 people. More seniors seem to be the main recipients of the pantry service.

The delivery charges will be increasing significantly in 2023. We will be looking into how to cover those charges.

The CAMPP kids will be handing out gift cards and goodie bags at the 12/14 distribution.

<u>Church business:</u> January 29, 2023 was set as the date for our annual congregational meeting.
